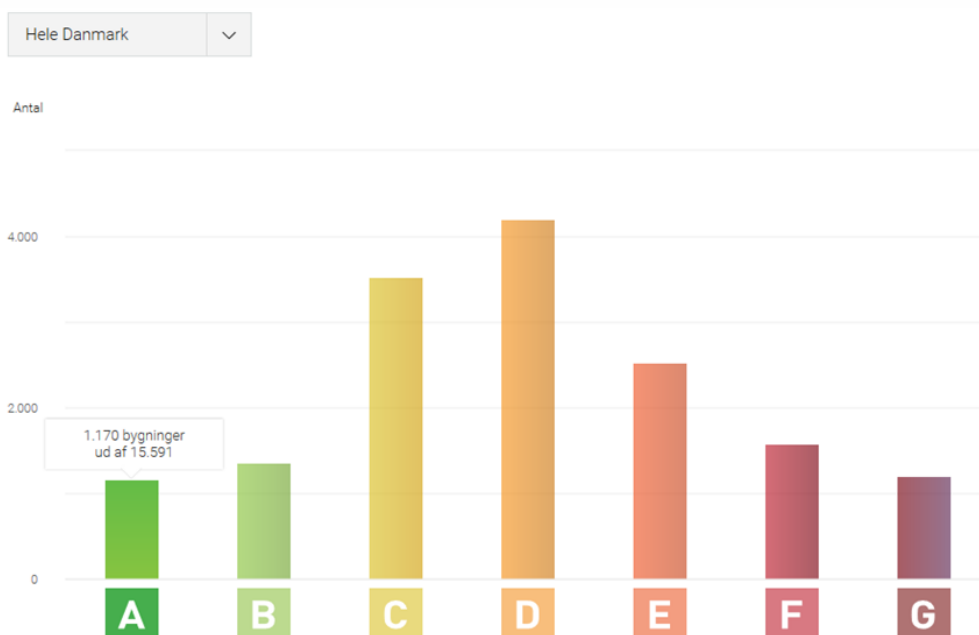


# Danish Commercial properties with EPC A-label

The figure below is a statistic showing the Energy Performance Certificates (EPCs) for commercial buildings in Denmark. The data is from the Danish Energy Agency's website ([www.spareenergi.dk](http://www.spareenergi.dk)) where all registered EPC's are published.

The EPC's are categorized in five sections: House related to farming, Detached house, Row house & Semi-detached house, Apartments and Stores & Offices.

The statistic shown below are the EPC on Stores & Offices and shows that 1.170 out of 15.591 buildings with EPC's are in category A. This means that commercial buildings holding an EPC A-label belong to the top 7.5pct most energy efficient commercial buildings in Denmark. As it is expected that new building are overrepresented in the EPC database, extending the analysis to the entire building stock would very likely result in an even lower share of than 7.5pct.
